

How to book your SAT

Step 1

Log in to your *College Board* account. Click on *My SAT* and then *Continue* if you are booking your first SAT or *Register for another SAT* if you have already sat one. You might need to confirm your password.

Step 2

Fill in all mandatory fields.

Click on *Find your school*, select *Outside the US* and your country, search and click on *Can't find your high school?* and select *My school is not listed*. Make sure your address is *Outside the US*.

Step 3

Continue through the pages filling mandatory fields. Do not bother to fill subject-by-subject pages - these are for American students and do not translate. Tick off the *Terms and Conditions* box.

Step 4

Choose the date and mark no at the *Fee Waiver* section and *Accommodation* (unless you have your disability documents sorted and approved). At the bottom you can choose if you want *Student Answer Service*. Make sure you have selected *SAT test* (subject tests are only required if you want to get into medicine, law or similar subjects)

Step 5

Select your test centre and upload your photo (make sure you check the requirements). Also you can buy extra study material (Note that they will be sending it from the US so, in most cases, it is better to buy it on Amazon or eBay).

Step 6

Check the information and proceed to the payment. Tick the agreement box. Select the payment method: you can pay by Debit and Credit Cards or PayPal.

Step 7

Print your ticket. Also press to *Send your Scores* - new window will pop up where you can search for NCAA and NAIA and add these governing bodies to the list. If you already know the college/university you are going to search and add it as well. You do not need to select the state to find the governing bodies, but you may need to do so looking for colleges/universities if they have a popular name.

Note, it is free to send your scores to 3 different institutions before the test results are out. If you send scores after the results are out it will cost you \$11 each time.
